1. Presentation by Ass.prof. Ana Lorena Ruano: Community-led accountability: experiences from Guatemala

Ana Lorena is a Research coordinator at Center for the Study of Equity and Governance in Health Systems (CEGSS). CEGSS encourage and work to support Independent and autonomous citizen (people) action. Using the existing legal framework (national and international) norms, policies and standards. Rights literacy campaigns among population. Capacity building: To monitor public policies and services and demand accountability from authorities. Information about a Guatemalan network funded by Fredskorpset. Collaboration between CEGSS and CIH

Fredskorpset, now NOREC, funds exchange projects between Norway and Asia, Africa and Latin America for under 35. Staff Exchanges can last 6, 12 or 18 months. Covers travel, language learning, housing plus a stipend. Norwegians citizens receive a larger grant in order to support running costs at home.
