#### **5. Cristin reporting See email from Gunhild 17/1-20.**

As you know from previous emails, a new requirement in Cristin demands that a full text of the article is uploaded in Cristin before we can approve the article for NVI reporting.

**By January 31**, researchers must ensure that a peer reviewed full-text version of all research articles are uploaded in Cristin. The author's accepted manuscript must be uploaded, unless the author has made sure that the publisher permits the published version of the article to be made openly available. Please see this tutorial on how to upload articles in Cristin

Attached is an updated list of articles that lack full text. The same article is listed several times where there are more than one author from IGS. Full text only needs to be uploaded one time.

#### **6. Prices We need to nominate CIH to different prices in 2020**

Each year, the faculty give out awards, Årets publikasjon, Årets ph.d.-arbeid, Pris for fremragende forskningsformidling, Årets forsknings-/innovasjonsmiljø (erstatter Årets forskningsgruppe) . This year, a main award for excellent education NOK 150,000, - and up to two prizes 50,000 each. New this year: Awards are no longer awarded to a certain number of predefined categories such as study quality, internationalization or teaching. Instead, there can be several winners if there are several outstanding applicants.

The deadline for submitting nominations is **February 24**. Individuals cannot be nominated. Academic community s can nominate themselves.
